<u>Call for Nominations - Chair of CSD</u> Australia

Nominations are invited for the position of Chair of CSD Australia. This is a national position with a term of three years. The term will be from September 2015 to approximately September 2018 (the date of the CSD Australia Triennial General Meeting in 2018 is not yet known).

As indicated in the CSD Australia Constitution, the role of the CSD Australia Chair is:

- to be national co-ordinator of CSD's activities
- to animate, encourage and support CSD members
- * to review and accept new members of CSD
- to oversee the planning and conduct of CSD conferences
- to prepare the agenda for the General Meetings
- * to attend to such items of business and decision-making required for the sake of CSD's life and mission.

The current incumbents in the roles that support the Chair - Reference Group members, Secretary/Treasurer, Website Manager - are all currently located in Melbourne Vic and so nominations of Victorian members is preferable, but not compulsory.

Retirement from CSD of Margaret Dwyer and Angela Dance

After years of membership with CSD, and more importantly, decades of service to others through their ministry, including spiritual direction, Margaret Dwyer and Angela Dance are retiring from CSD.

Margaret Dywer rsc achieved her Master in Sacred Theology in California, USA in 1979. For nearly 20 years, she was a spiritual director at the Marymount Mercy (Spirituality) Centre in Castle Hill, codirecting the Renewal program there. She followed on to the Emmanuel Centre for the next 10 years, co-ordinating spiritual direction in Hobart.

News from ACT (Liz-Anne Smith)

Wishing to take seriously our Code of Ethics of Spiritual Directors, especially the responsibility to be faithful to ongoing formation, and as professionals to take

seriously the call through the Holy Spirit to be artisans of our ongoing formation, we decided to embark on a more formal process of formation which includes reading a selected book and sharing our reflections, preparing and presenting verbatims using the contemplative supervision process, and using DVDs as resource material on occasions. This group meets monthly for a two-hour session, preceded by prayer.

The group also discerned a need to participate in being trained in methods of supervision that would further support and enhance others seeking professional supervision.

To make the group occasions wholistic, personally and professionally supportive, we also celebrate each other's life with a celebratory lunch.

Our formation program for this year includes reflecting on 'Knowing Ourselves' The Gospel of John by Jean Vanier, sessions reflecting on Sacred Fire by Ronald Rolheiser, watching Hesychia DVDs (The Sacred Intimate; Contemplative Listening for the Director), the sharing of resources and three celebratory lunches.
