Dear Fellow CSD Members & Friends,


Welcome to another new year and what a year 2016 is for our Association. CSD celebrates its 30th anniversary since inception in 1986.

Experiences of God's Unconditional Love

For our final gathering for 2015, directors gathered at the Emmanuel Centre in Launceston for a weekend of prayer and reflection on the reality of God's unconditional love for all of us. Specifically the time together addressed the following purposes:

- To experience the unconditional love of God.
- To remind ourselves of God's ubiquitous presence.
- $\circ\;$ To enjoy being with each other and our God.
- To provide an update on the recent AESCD Conference in Adelaide.

Time was made as part of our Friday night welcome to remember and pray for Sr Trish Dance who died quite suddenly earlier in 2015. Trish's deep faith, warmth, wisdom and intelligent leadership has been critical to the provision of adult faith formation and spiritual direction in Tasmania and beyond for many years. Those present shared their fond memories of a blessed woman much loved by us all and still very much spiritually present to us. God's unconditional love was explored through a number of lens with the implicit message being that "vulnerability leads to intimacy with God".

Firstly meditative silence encouraged us to let go and listen to the inner movements of the spirit within. Use was made of the poetic gifts of Marlene Marburg's writings to allow 'the poetry of prayer to open our hearts right down to the sternum'.

The creative expression of God's love was experienced through artistic play with mandalas with participants taking their art to direction for further contemplation and insight. Some excerpts of the letters of St Paul were shared. Paul wrote in love to his friends in all the new Churches; love for the people and love for God. Paul was so head-over-heels in love with God that he just couldn't help asking God to share that love with everyone. We were invited to be drawn to one of these pieces of scripture and recognise something of that love?

The weekend concluded with a report on the AESCD conference being provided by those who were able to attend from Tasmania.

Our prayer was enriched by music and opportunities to share what was happening for us in our becoming more deeply aware of how passionately we are loved by God as we are!
